ORDER NO. 172,797

Revocable permission is granted to the Eureka Valley Promotion Association and the Concerned Castro Neighbors to perform certain functions, improvements and maintenance on the triangular property located at 17th and Market Streets. The purpose of this permission is to alleviate a public health hazard, beautify an eyesore along the public right-of-way, provide a safe pedestrian pathway and commemorate victims of gay and lesbian persecution. The specific temporary items permitted are:

- To provide a pedestrian pathway through the property where no sidewalk currently exists and a hazard to pedestrian safety exists.
- To regularly remove litter, trash, homeless debris, needles and other waste from the site.
- To plant, weed, water and maintain a rose garden on the site.
- To place a memorial to gay and lesbian victims of the Nazi Holocaust on this site in conjunction with the San Francisco Art Commission.

The Bureau of Street Environmental Services is to monitor and review the installation, maintenance and conditions of all functions and improvements performed by the permittees and prepare an annual assessment as to the success of the actions and report to the Director of Public Works. Temporary permission for the above named functions, improvements and installations shall be permitted until such time that the Director revokes the permission for non-performance of maintenance or other reasons at his sole discretion.
